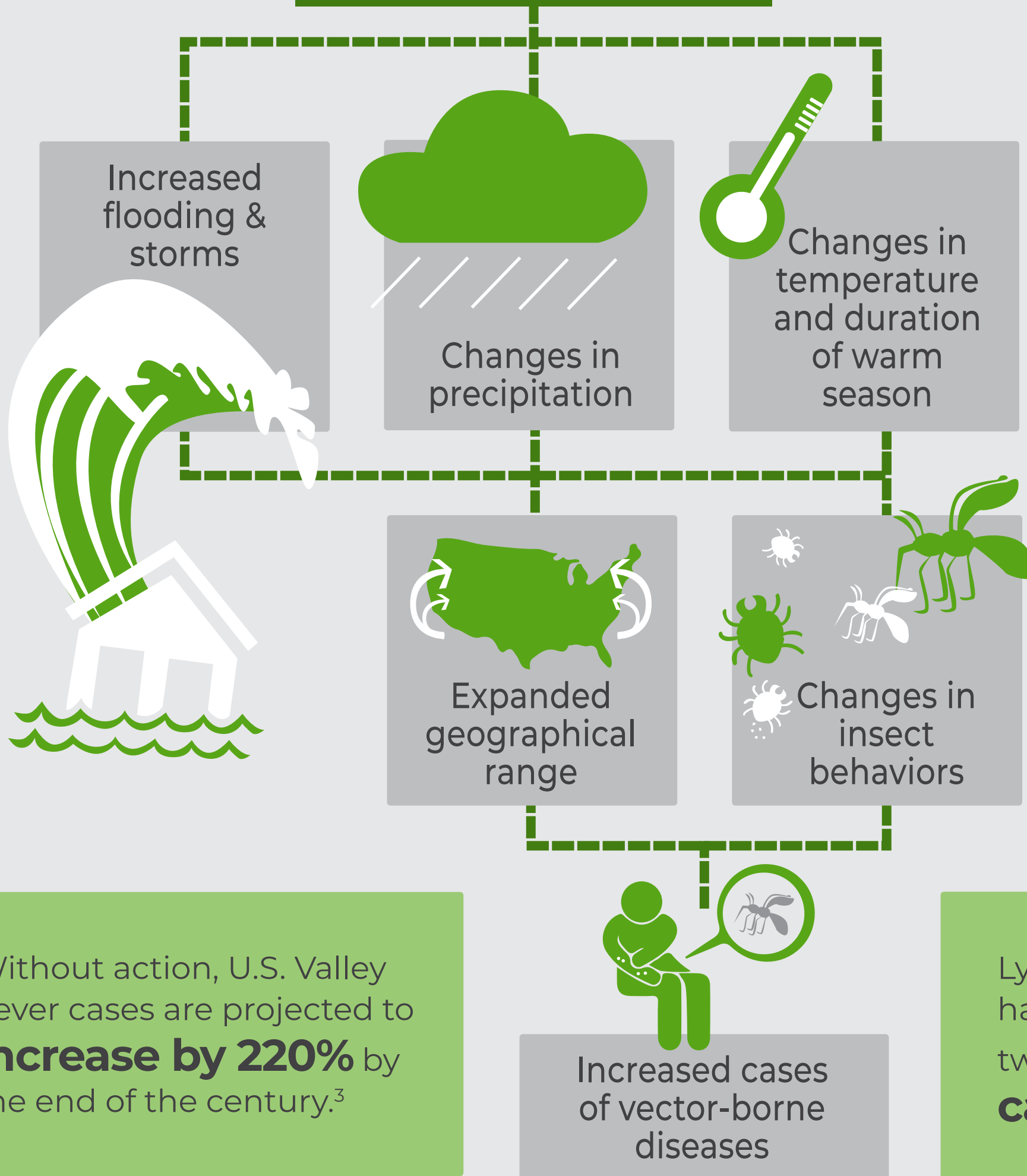


HOW CLIMATE CHANGE AFFECTS YOUR HEALTH

VECTOR-BORNE DISEASES



56,575 cases of West Nile Virus in the U.S. since 1999, of which more than **2,776 people have died.**¹

Four states reported locally-acquired cases of malaria in 2023, including the first in Texas in nearly 30 years and the first in Maryland in nearly 40 years.²

Without action, U.S. Valley Fever cases are projected to **increase by 220%** by the end of the century.³

Lyme disease incidence has doubled over the past two decades to **30,000 cases per year.**⁴
